What should I include in my proposal submission?

1. Completed [online application](#)
Email notification will be sent verifying receipt.
2. Resumes (not vitae) for each presenter
Please email resumes directly to gayconference@gaeyc.net with subject line: GAYC CFP 2016.
3. BFTS (Bright from the Start) approval letter if your presentation has previously received approval – Please email training approval along with resumes to gayconference@gaeyc.net with subject line: GAYC CFP 2016.

How do I submit my proposal?

Submissions are accepted online via our CFP Google Form only. Supplemental materials, e.g. resumes & approval letters, should be sent to gayconference@gaeyc.net with subject line: GAYC CFP 2016

How long are the workshop sessions?

Proposals are being sought for in 1.5 hour workshops. Proposals offer new and innovative presentations, evidence-based best practices, and presentations that rely on solid research-grounded work in the early childhood field. Key topic areas are listed within the online application. If you have presented at a GAYC conference previously, please submit a new presentation– no repeats please!
